# MNYFO Wednesday Night Derby Rules

- 1. Anglers will receive an email and text message from Reel Livewell Champions Tour Team Invitation, with their PIN # for the event.
- 2. Make sure to have the Reel Livewell app downloaded to your mobile device and logged-in using your PIN to access the event. The app will list the derby under Fish Details Entry when registered and logged in.
- **3.** It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that the BOAT CAPTAIN logs into the app using an angler PIN to enter fish catches.
- 4. On tournament day, launch your boat and head out to your spot ahead of time. The Fish Details Entry button will be live at 4pm, at which time you can put lines in the water. Lines out at 8pm, head back to landing at that time.
- 5. NO FISH ARE TO BE PLACED IN LIVEWELL AT ANY TIME DURING THE EVENT!
- 6. Artificial lures only. No Live Bait.
- 7. All teams must use the uniform SATT/Scheels ruler that must be present in all photos.
- 8. Enter your fish catch in the app. All fish MUST be 12" minimum to enter.
- 9. To measure a fish, make sure the fish is placed flat on ruler with mouth closed and pressed flush to the bump board. Pinch or fan tail to the nearest ¼ inch. If the tail hits the line, the next ¼ inch will be awarded. You may round up 1/4 ".
- 10. Two photos must accompany all fish entries. One photo MUST be of the fish on the ruler. It must be clear and visible and show the entire fish. If you can't read it, neither can we. The other photo can be a full picture of the angler with the fish.
- 11. Inches will be converted to weight based on the conversion scale located in app.
- 12. All anglers MUST wear life jackets and be seated while the outboard engine is running. No Power Trolling.
- **13.** Boat Captains MAY do the following:
  - Run the trolling motor
  - Net fish
  - Help tie knots
  - Remove hooks from fish
  - It is recommended Boat Captains control the app/enter fish catches.
- 14. Points will be awarded based on finish, 1<sup>st</sup> = 100 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 99, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 98, etc. Points from top 6 (six) out of 12 (twelve) events will be totaled for JWC consideration.
- 15. All advancing teams must fish TBF Jr State Championship.
- 16. Trophies will be awarded to each angler on the team with the most points 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place, and Big Bass Award to the angler that caught it.
- 17. Drawing at each event for Mystery Tackle Boxes for a random team.
- 18. All anglers will walk away with a free lure or package of soft plastics at each event.
