

Tournament Information Sheet

1. Mandatory in person rules meeting will be held at *6pm the night before the event*. **Check in will start at 5pm.** The boat captain must attend to get boat numbers, bump board stickers & parking dash card.
2. It is the responsibility of each angler & boat captain to have read, understand & follow all tournament rules. Find rules document [HERE](#)
3. **Parking: We are required to have a parking plan for our DNR Permit.**
 - a. We conduct parking checks at each designated landing. **If your vehicle is found parked at a location that does not match your sign-up, or if your dashboard card is not displayed, your team may be disqualified from the tournament.**
4. Quick Rules Review & National Anthem held at 6:45am on Saturday morning virtually via Google Meet & our Facebook page. [National Anthem Link](#)
5. You can launch your boat at any time but you **may NOT begin fishing until 7am**. Fishing will **end at 1pm**.
6. DNR permitted waters are off limits for fishing as of 5:30pm the night before the event.
7. No kids are allowed to drive or operate the boat when the big motor (combustible engine) is running. Except for loading and unloading the boat.
8. **Life jackets must be worn while the combustion engine is running. NO inflatables for students. No standing up while the big motor is running & the boat is moving.**
9. No trolling or fishing using the big motor.
10. Live bait is **NOT** permitted in this tournament.
11. The boat captain **can NOT fish**, make casts, hold a rod, etc.
12. The boat captain **CAN** tie knots, help with snags, net fish, operate trolling motor, unhook fish.
13. Minimum countable length of a smallmouth or largemouth bass is 12". If the tail of the fish touches a line you will round up ¼". The app will cull your fish for you and count your top 7 fish.
14. Fish must be registered on an SATT branded ruler. **This is the ONLY ruler accepted.**
15. **All pictures must be taken in the Time Stamp app and then uploaded into the Fishing Chaos app.** We must be able to clearly see that the lip of the fish is touching the bump board, **mouth is 100 % closed** and be able to see the tail of the fish on the ruler in one picture in order for the fish to count.



16. If you have a fish that has a deformity that does not allow the fish's mouth to close all the way please lay the fish with the deformity facing up so it is clearly shown in the photo. Also take a photo of the deformity if we need a better photo at time of verification.
17. Absolutely **no** fish in the boat LiveWell at any time. **If you catch a fish you are not permitted to fish again until that fish is released.**
- 18. Please check your fish entries throughout the day. You will see, denied on your entry if a fish is rejected with a reason. If you have a better photo you can resubmit. The App is NOT final until we announce the winners at the awards.**
19. Check the flyers at the bottom for more information.
20. The app will shut off at 1:30pm. You will have until 1:30pm to contact one of us to report issues prior to 1:30pm or those fish will NOT count.
21. The awards will be held at 2:00pm. We will send a text message if that time changes.
